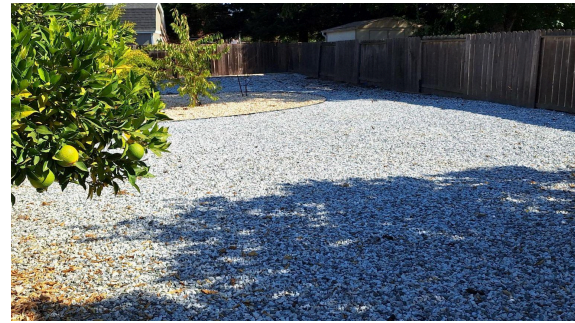
Front Yard

- Replace the white rock in front yard with artificial grass
- Add an inverted triangle inside of the triangle, replace The cream colored rock with the rocks in that inverted triangle with the white rock that was formerly in the front yard.
- Add 2 rose bushes in front of the house. These rose bushes should each be planted in wooden barrel pots.
- One of these bushes should be an Orange Glow Knock Out Rose, or a Pat Austin Rose if the Orange Glow Rose is unavailable.
- The other Rose bush should be a It's a Breeze Red Rose or a Ring of Fire Hybrid Tea Rose if the Breeze Rose is unavailable. Plant the rose bush in a wooden barrel pot.
- Add a drip line timer, fabric weed preventing cover around each of the rose bushes and cover the pots with some of the leftover white rocks.
- Add a fabric weed preventing cover around the tree in the front yard and cover the area with some of the leftover white rocks.



Back Yard

- Use the same type of paver Stones that were used in the previous project to make a 3 stone wide path.
- The path should lead to a new patio roughly 19'x21' made of paver stones.
- Erect a new gazebo
- The New gazebo should be the AMERLIFE 13x15 Wood Gazebo, Hardtop Gazebo with Iron Roof Double Roof, Outdoor Gazebo with Wood Frame for Patio, Garage, Lawns, Parties, Black + Natural Wood

- Add in a new metal dining set. That dining set should be the: Contemporary Modern 7-Piece Bronze Aluminum Outdoor Dining Set with Lazy Susan

- Add 4 Enduring Summer Red Crape Myrtle trees 1 on the east side, 1 on the south side 2 on the West. If Enduring Summer Red Crape Myrtle is unavailable, use Cherry Dazzle Dwarf Crape Myrtle or Berry Dazzle Dwarf Crape Myrtle as a substitute.



- Add 4 Bellini Grape Dwarf Crape Myrtle trees 1 on the east side, 1 on the west side and 2 on the south. If the Bellini Grape tree is unavailable use bonsai blue jacaranda trees or Berry Dazzle Dwarf Crape Myrtle trees instead.
- We want 4 columnar Apple Trees placed on the north side of the gazebo. One of each of these types: Blushing Delight columnar apple tree, Tangy Green columnar apple tree, North Pole columnar apple tree, & Golden Treat columnar apple tree.
- On the East side of the gazebo we would like to have a Dwarf Everbearing Mulberry Tree. Also on the East Side we want to plant a tangerine tree into a pot.
- We want all of these plants to be placed in 16-18 inch in diameter wooden barrel pots. Add a drip line timer, fabric weed preventing cover around each of the rose bushes and cover the pots with some of the leftover white rocks. However we want the mulberry tree to be planted in a smaller wooden barrel pot. Preferably one with a 12-14 inch diameter
- The 2 sheds in the back need to be torn down and replaced. We would like to replace them with 1 wooden shed.
- We would like to have the two sheds emptied, torn down, have the new wooden shed be built in the same spot as the old shed, and have the contents from the old sheds put into the new shed. The type of shed we would like to use is the Heartland Statesman 10-ft x 16-ft Wood Storage Shed (Floor Included).

- Some of the main branches on the plum tree in the back have broken. We need them cut up into smaller pieces that can be put into the yard waste recycling bin. We also need the remaining branches trimmed back.
- Remaining white rock can be used to cover up the empty areas where the old sheds originally were (plus weed preventing fabric cover), along the side of the house (also add weed preventing fabric), along fence lines on the north and east ends, and fill in any areas where the amount of rock are thin.
- We would also like a paver stone cut and placed just outside of the gate. Also just a little before the gate near the fence we would like a metal pole added into the ground and it

concrete it in. The purpose for the pole is for something that Theresa can hold onto when she comes back into the back yard.
